Wobblers 1-2 years

In a our Wobbler Room children will be starting to find their feet, becoming adventurers, exploring more and more each day, which is so much fun to see. As parents we will involve you in you child's development each day. From the age of 1 to 2 years children need more structure. A weekly and monthly plan will be in place which our staff will follow; this will also enable you to have visibility of what your Wobbler will be up to during the day.

There will be an assortment of toys in this room such as push & pull toys, toys that make music, building blocks, baby tools, buggy's, dolls and a ball pool etc.

At the Wobbler stage you child will understand every day words at home and be trying some themselves, our staff will also promote and introduce words to your child which is very important.

Different activities will be introduced. To aid the development of gross and fine manipulation skills, tools such as a treasure basket containing articles of different shapes, sizes and textures will be enjoyed. When children are in groups at singing time our staff will encourage lots of fun and interaction which fun not only for the wobblers, but also entertainment for the staff as there will lots babbling going on, this will be encouraged as they are expressing themselves.

Outdoor play will be promoted at least twice per day where possible.

Art and work will be displayed in their room and taken home when each new theme starts each month.

As you can imagine or already know, wobblers love to examine and investigate the feel and texture of new things..... especially food! That is why we will encourage them to begin learning how to feed themselves, and request a change of clothes.
